**S.92A INTERIM ORDER FOR NAME SUPPRESSION OF PRACTITIONER AND S.98 ORDER FOR
NAME SUPPRESSION OF COMPLAINANT**

- [1] An application for interim name suppression was filed on behalf of the practitioner on 6 August 2021.
- [2] In a Memorandum of Counsel for the PCC dated 13 August 2021, the PCC consented to an application for an interim order to be made but indicated that any application for permanent name suppression would be opposed.
- [3] The Chair has considered the application and as the PCC has consented to an interim order being made, is satisfied that the application is appropriate. A section 92A order for interim name suppression of the practitioner and any details that may identify him, is made until further order of the Tribunal.
- [4] The making of this order does not indicate the outcome of an application for permanent name suppression should one be made.
- [5] The PCC sought a section 98 application for the suppression of the name of the complainant and any details that may identify her.
- [6] The Chair is satisfied that a section 98 order is appropriate in this case. A permanent order for non-publication of the name and any identifying details of the complainant is made.
